



**CIVILIAN SERVICE RIFLE MARKSMANSHIP SKILLS COURSE
SATURDAY 14 MAY 2016 - ALT CAR RANGES**

AIM: The Civilian Service Rifle (CSR) Marksmanship Skills Course is aimed at improving the shooting skills of owners of various CSR-type rifles. This includes Historic Enfields such as SMLE, No 4 or No 5, AR-15 style platforms with Iron or Optical Sights, and bolt-action rifles such as the Remington 700, Accuracy International AI/AW with bi-pods and scopes. The NRA actively encourages young shooters by offering 40% discount on all training and competitions for Under 25s.

COURSE DETAIL: The course will be staged at Altcar Ranges and will involve both classroom and practical range work (including target marking), with expert coaching from national level shooters. Shooting positions will be revised and practised, with tips on shooting from each position: prone, sitting, kneeling/squatting and standing.

The course is open to full NRA members/full members of NRA affiliated clubs, including those who do not currently hold an FAC or possess the appropriate firearm, but have successfully completed the required probationary course. Non NRA members/full members of NRA affiliated clubs can attend if in possession of the appropriate firearm and by paying the additional course fee.

COURSE FEE: £55.00 Under 25s: £33.00 (includes range fees, targets, scorebook and individual coaching). Ammunition and firearms are not included and attendees are expected to bring their own.

FIREARMS: Those not yet in possession of a firearm can hire a scoped AR-15 type rifle from the NRA for £18 for the day, and purchase ammunition (100 rds of 62gr 5.56 mm at a special price of £32) upon production of their NRA membership card and Shooter Certification Card (SCC). SCC assessments can be offered as part of the course for no additional fee. If this is required please let us know.

DRESS AND EQUIPMENT: Light Goretex jackets are recommended with under layers according to the weather, and suitable lightweight walking-type trousers with waterproof over trousers if required. Jeans and heavy cotton trousers are not suitable. You will need:

- Ear defenders
- Firearm
- Approximately 100 rds ammunition
- Normal shooting equipment
- Notebook and pencil

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: Tea and coffee will be available during the classroom sessions of the course at no extra charge. Candidates should bring their own lunch.
